Brisbane Broncos

Broncos Leagues Club is a platinum sponsor of the Brisbane Broncos and has been since their inception in 1988. In excess of \$10 million has been provided in sponsorship during this period. This money has been used to fund junior development and recruitment programs and has been critical in finding the stars of not only the future but the present time including previous captain of the Brisbane Broncos, Queensland and Australia, Darren Lockyer.

Wests Juniors

Wests Juniors Rugby League Football Club based at Purtell Park has 20 teams in the South East Division Juniors Competition from Under 7's to Under 16's. Broncos Leagues Club

makes a cash donation of close to \$25,000 plus purchases the jerseys for each player, total support of worth \$40,000 per annum.

Red Hill Community Sports Club

Red Hill Community Sports Club is the recently established amalgamation of Ithaca Bowls Club, Normanby Hounds Rugby League Football Club, and Ashgrove RSL. Located at 22 Fulcher Road Red Hill this club provides services and facilities to in excess of 50 community groups, charities, schools, and non for profit organisations. Red Hill Special School

The Red Hill Special School located on Waterworks Road is a co-educational State School which provides educational programs for up to 50 students who have multiple impairments. Camp Quality

Camp Quality is a non profit organization that is committed to bringing hope and happiness to children, families and communities living with cancer. Broncos Leagues Club operates 5 bingo sessions per week and \$3,000 from these sessions are donated per annum to Camp Quality.

Broncos Old Boys

Broncos Leagues Club is proud to be the major sponsor of the Broncos Old Boys who in addition to running events for current and former players to continue the friendships and bonds forged on the field run junior rugby league competitions including the Michael Hancock Cup for Under 14's and the Steve Renouf Shield for Under 13's.

Active School Travel Program

Brisbane City Council's Active School Travel Program aims to change travel behavior to and from school. Broncos Leagues Club assists the families of St Finbarr's Catholic Primary School at Ashgrove by providing access to its car park on the school's

dedicated Active Travel Day. This allows parents to park and walk with their children to the school. Broncos Leagues Club also provides support in a number of non-financial ways.

Kim Walters Choices Program

Choices is dedicated to the memory of Kim Walters, husband of Kevin Walters. The program provides free support for those with or affected by breast or gynecological cancer. Broncos Leagues Club selected Choices to be the charity partner or beneficiary of this year's Melbourne Cup Lunch. With 220 people in attendance over \$4,500 was raised for Kim Walters Choices Program.

Paraplegic Benefit Fund

PBF's mission is to reduce the incidence and impact of spinal cord injury through their PBF Prevention programs, their gifting program for the Paraquad community and by supporting research into a cure for permanent paralysis. Broncos Leagues Club is a corporate member of the PBF and also provides free membership for its employees at \$24 per person each year.
